Seethamma (Professor and Head, Former Director, Centre for Women Studies, Department of Economics, Bangalore University, Bangalore), Member Coordinator and Dr. Siddhartha Gupta (Principal, Bankura Zilla Saradamani Mahila Mahavidyapith, Bankura), Member, visited the college on April 16–18, 2012 for Assessment and Accreditation under the directions of NAAC. On the basis of the report submitted by the team to NAAC, the college could get B grade accreditation.

It was all due to the untiring joint efforts of the Teachers, Non- Teaching Staffs, Students, Alumni, Parents, Local Guardians, etc for Development of Higher Education in the state and the country in general. Part C

Future Plan for the Year

The college has been striving for the past one year to achieve extensive progress in all fields. To build up a promising future for the college especially in back drop of the preparations for the re-accreditation, it is necessary that the programmes previously planned are materialized to the hilt. To assess the extent of work that remains unfulfilled, the routine team visits to the departments should be arranged well in advance and necessary guidance should be imparted to all individuals and departments to wrap up their previous programmes expeditiously.

The college assures place emphatic efforts in building character of the students in imparting values, ethical and moral, given the level of penetration made by technology in the form om of IT. Moral education in addition to the regular course works needs to be arranged regularly for the students and a year long programme to this effect should be chalked out by a committee constituted for this purpose. To increase the efficiency of the teaching staff and orientate them for the task entrusted it is appropriate that at least two renewal seminars are arranged in the course of the year.

The computerization of the library is an imperative which should be addressed promptly to maximize the use of the library facilities of the college. It is suggested that experts in this field should be appointed on contract basis to complete the work on war-footing so that the library complements the lecture classes attended by students.

Considering the fact that the college caters to large number of students from backward classes, remedial coaching for those students who lag behind in their studies has become the need of the hour. Most of these students do not have access to the facilities enjoyed by students having proximity to big cities. Instead they hail from impecunious families of the hill districts which can not afford to provide them even their prescribed text books. More over they lack the proper training secured from schools with adequate facilities and hence they find it extremely difficult to cope with the studies. To ameliorate the learning conditions of these students programmes of remedial coaching should be drawn up by a core committee entrusted with this task.

Realizing the practical difficulties of keeping attended records up to date computerization of the attendance work is mooted by the IQAC. This can reduce the work load in the office and supply the necessary data at the click of the mouse. It is also necessary to expedite work of revitalizing the department-wise Alumni association and the heads of various departments should make positive efforts to contact the Alumni of their respective department without delay. Their activities should be coordinated profitably for the institution and present generation.
